It's meeting time again!

April brings in our various annual meetings of our district churches and then there's the big one: the **Annual Parish Church Meeting (APCM) on 25 April 2018 at 8pm in Tring Church.** There can be a temptation to yawn and try and come up with a suitable excuse for avoiding them. This year, why not come along? For it is an important way of learning how the church is faring: how are we reaching out to our local residents; what have we done to deepen people's faith; how many baptisms have there been; are we financially sound and what about our buildings? The whole of our church life is reviewed. We look back at what's happened and we settle on what some of the future holds and who will help to lead us through it.

Last year Huw put together a video showing a lot of what took place in 2016-2017 which he showed at the APCM. I was amazed by all that happened in that year from moments of sadness to fun times. We achieve a lot together and our church meetings are a way of acknowledging that. None of this just happens and we rely on a huge number of people to deliver all that we deliver as a community. So our APCM and the district meetings are a start to our thinking how we are going to do it this year.

Despite my best efforts, if the prospect of these still seems a bit dull and detailed, take a peek at the Gospel. Notice that in all the great news about the resurrection, Luke thought a bit of detail was important and so he told us Jesus had broiled fish for breakfast. If it's good enough for Luke, a bit of time and detail for us for a couple of evenings in wet April might not be so bad.

So please come along to your local district church meeting **and** the APCM.
