God of glory, the end of our searching, help us to lay
aside all that prevents us from seeking your kingdom, and
to give all that we have to gain the pearl beyond all price,
through our Saviour Jesus Christ.

Post Communion Sentence

Lord of all mercy, we your faithful people have celebrated
that one true sacrifice which takes away our sins and
brings pardon and peace: by our communion keep us firm
on the foundation of the gospel and preserve us from all
sin; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

On Wednesday next week the Church celebrates the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Church of England's liturgy book writes "Mary was a young Jewish girl living in Nazareth when a messenger from the Lord announced that she was to be the bearer of the Son of God to the world. Her response 'Let it be to me according to your word' revealed her natural sense of obedience to God and her reverence for his word, showing her worthy to be the bearer of the Word made flesh. This day is now celebrated as the major feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary throughout most of Christendom."

Our church in Puttenham is dedicated to St Mary. We believe that we have been faithfully listening to the Lord in Puttenham and we have done three things: improve the building; open the church all day every Sunday and to have a service every Sunday (rather than just twice a month). Of course the village of Puttenham is tiny so if the church is to thrive it needs others who like the style of worship offered in this beautiful country church. By and large this is the simple worship from the Book of Common Prayer. On the first Sunday it is a communion, this afternoon is a said evening prayer and on the fourth Sunday we have a sung evening prayer with a small choir. For those who love the Book of Common Prayer, and who want to see it continue in the Church of England, I commend these services to you. The other service in Puttenham is on the third Sunday (i.e. next week) we have Taize worship. If you like a prayerful, reflective style of worship with a simple musical style you might find this to be a real gem of a service and the highlight of your month.

As we come to remember the Blessed Virgin Mary, pray too for all at St Mary's Puttenham
