Faithful Lord, whose steadfast love never ceases and whose mercies never come to an end: grant us the grace to trust you and to receive the gifts of your love, new every morning, in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Post Communion Sentence

Holy and blessed God, you have fed us with the body and blood of your Son and filled us with your Holy Spirit: may we honour you, not only with our lips but in lives dedicated to the service of Jesus Christ our Lord.

It is a huge contrast as we continue our harvest celebrations to see on the news the terrible pictures of the devastation in Indonesia. We cannot imagine what it must be like for those people to have no shelter, food or water. It also follows on from widespread damage caused by the typhoon in Kerala, and the typhoon in the Philippines. What can we do?

It was after one of the school shootings in America, that there was a social media campaign which said "we do not want your prayers – we want action". People were fed up with the platitudes publicly spouted that said "our prayers and thoughts are with you", but nothing changed. We can feel the same way sometimes. But there is always something that we can do, and prayer is part of it. We pray for those who grieve, who are in pain, and who are angry and frightened. We pray for those in charge of rescue and rebuilding; and we pray for those who lead governments and NGOs, that they may make the right decisions. We can also give – our time to organisations like Christian Aid and the Red Cross whether through helping in their shops, promoting what they do, and supporting them. We can also give our money, and do so in the way that means that the most goes to those who need it. This means being generous, using gift aid, and encouraging others to give. And it also means changing how we live – if this beautiful world which has God has given us is damaged by what we do, so that others suffer, then we have to change and show that we care.

May I urge you to do something, as well as to hold in prayer those who are in such difficulties. It is not an either/or!
