God, our light and our salvation: illuminate our lives, that we may see your goodness in the land of the living, and looking on your beauty may be changed into the likeness of Jesus Christ our Lord.

### Post Communion Sentence

God our Father, whose Son, the light unailing, has come from heaven to deliver the world from the darkness of ignorance: let these holy mysteries open the eyes of our understanding that we may know the way of life, and walk in it without stumbling; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

For those of you in Tring and Long Marston at 10 am last Sunday, I hope that you enjoyed the clap hands Gloria. If you weren't there it is in the hymn book (222 or 964 in the Orange Aldbury ones). It was new to me, but many folk have used it in different settings and it brings a joy to that hymn of praise. It is certainly true that it is not a formal Gloria in the way that a Eucharistic setting like Merbecke might be, however it is not right to dismiss it as happy-clappy. This seems to be a new pejorative term in the Church. Involving the whole body in music and worship is for some a very good thing. The writer of the clap hands Gloria, Mike Anderson is a Roman Catholic and writes mainly for his church, so it is not some trendy evangelical worship either, but enables (some) to access the worship and to deepen their faith in a different way.

Deepening our faith is really at the heart of what we do and I would like to take this opportunity to re – commend three ways you might like to do this. Firstly be part of one of our house groups. These discussion groups are get ways to share, to grow and to learn. Secondly we have a parish book group, and even if you don't get on with book groups, you might like to read the same books as us. Last month's book was excellent, Another Bloody Retreat, and this month we are reading a book from the bible – Nehemiah. We can learn from the life of Nehemiah valuable lessons in restoring and maintaining a relationship with God. Finally we have a new resource for you. We will be posting the Roots "live your faith" material onto our website and facebook page. This will give you some Bible notes for the lectionary readings, some questions for thought and some prayers. This might give you some ways to deepen what we hear in our weekly sermons.
