Alternative Collect

God, our refuge and strength, bring near the day when wars shall cease and poverty and pain shall end, that earth may know the peace of heaven through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Post Communion Sentence

God of peace, whose Son Jesus Christ proclaimed the kingdom and restored the broken to wholeness of life: look with compassion on the anguish of the world, and by your healing power make whole both people and nations; through our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

I have been ordained for 20 years now and throughout that time everyone has talked about the demise of the church. I think I have come to the conclusion that this is just wrong. The church is certainly in a period of change but it most certainly isn't on its knees (apart from when we are at prayer, but actually very few people pray kneeling down these days).

The great events of human history are still best marked with a spiritual dimension. I have no idea how we would mark the 100th Anniversary of the end of World War I if there was no room for acknowledging human sinfulness and no place for the hope of God's redemption. The church still clearly has a place within society.

Folk also tell us about declining numbers. Well I want to celebrate. Over the 20 years of ministry confirmation has always been a key part of what we do. However, never can I remember when we have had confirmations in successive years. People might say we always used to, but not in my memory. Last year nine members of the Tring Team Parish were confirmed and this year another four members of youth café and at least five adults will be confirmed, and others are interested for next year too! So why don't you all join us on Wednesday 21st November at 7.30 pm in St Peter and St Paul's church with Bishop Michael and let us celebrate that the future of the church is looking good.
