Holy Week – come along and be part of it

Holy Week starts today, Palm Sunday. I am not going to repeat Huw's commentary on what happens during this week but I will echo his call to come and share in it. This is not because we are particularly interested in boosting church attendance for the sake of it but because what we do in the next seven days is central to our calling as Christians.

We remember, we give thanks and we mark the important days and events that lead to Easter. We do not do this as people sitting on the side lines unaffected by what has happened but because we too are caught up in the story of what Jesus did for us.

I am sure that I have betrayed Jesus like Judas in putting my own interests first. I am sure I have denied Christ like Peter when I was likely to be derided. I am sure I have fled like the disciples when it was important for me to save face rather than to stand by my faith. I am sure I have wept by the cross like Mary at what we have done to Jesus. I thank God that I am one who is forgiven like everyone else thanks to the passion, crucifixion and remarkable resurrection of Christ.

After what seems like an incredibly long Lent, it's finally here, Holy Week. So come along. Be part of our Holy Week in the Tring Team. I hope that it may: move us, challenge us, deepen our faith and that we see and believe more profoundly what God has done.
