Gracious Father, revive your Church in our day, and make her holy, strong and faithful, for your glory's sake in Jesus Christ our Lord.

#### **Post Communion Sentence.**

Holy Father, who gathered us here around the table of your Son to share this meal with the whole household of God: in that new world where you reveal the fullness of your peace, gather people of every race and language to share in the eternal banquet of Jesus Christ our Lord.

When or where do you feel closest to God?

Many people say they feel close to God when gazing at breathe-taking scenery or when out on nature walks, and whilst of course this can be the case, these are not the only places we encounter a spiritual presence.

Often we meet God in the most unremarkable of places; it might be during making a cup of tea, or in the 'good morning' glances we share with a stranger, it could be as we put the bins out or during the embrace a loved one. The truth is, God is present in all we do, there is no moment when God is not around.

This week's reading from Jeremiah starts with saying exactly this – that God occupies all places, the whole of heaven and earth and in every secret place. It may not seem this way given that we cannot see him and we are all guilty at times of thinking God may not be paying attention, however he is.

In the coming days, consider what God is doing at the most unlikely of times in your life, make an effort to be mindful of where he is in the ordinary, be open and listen, what you get in return may surprise you.....
